“Do you think you can help?”

“What is a subluxation?”

Let’s start this conversation by first gaining a deeper appreciation for how your body works.

“Why would a child need to get adjusted?”

People seem to forget what it is like to be a child. A child’s body takes daily abuse from the start. First, there is the twisting and pulling that occurs during the birthing process. Then, there are the falls from couches and the hits to the bottom as they learn to walk.

Regardless, for someone who believes chiropractic is all about pain, it may still be difficult to understand a child’s need for care. They’re thinking, despite these traumas, this child can’t possibly suffer the same pains as an adult. And they’re probably right, but what they’re forgetting is that chiropractic is not about eliminating pain. It’s about reconnecting a person to their power within; the pain relief is just a side-effect. As a reminder, the power within is the guiding force behind all life and healing. It works its magic via the nerve system and exists inside us all, including children.

And just as an adult can have a spinal misalignment that disconnects them from this power, so can a child. In fact, this disconnect can occur right at birth and lead to many childhood ailments doctors typically view as deficiencies or genetic predispositions. You see, diagnoses are a direct reflection of how well a person’s body is working. So, if the body isn’t working well from the start, due to interference to the power, of course there will be diagnoses.

What’s awesome is that if interference to the power is the cause of their problem, an adjustment can reconnect them, allowing their body to work as intended. With the power on, the diagnoses that once strapped this child with a label and a lifetime of pills is eliminated, providing a fresh start.

“Is that normal?”

This question comes up when I reveal a person’s exam findings. Psychologically speaking, I understand and appreciate why people ask this question. They want to know they are no worse off than anyone else. For some reason, knowing they are no worse off puts them at ease. This thinking is dangerous.

My pastor once said... “You need to stop doing what is normal, when normal is no longer good for you.” Brilliant!

Most of our society is overweight. Does that make it okay? Heck no. Most people that walk through my doors have lost proper spinal position and are subluxated. Does that make it okay? Heck no.

If I tell people it is “normal,” it gives them license to do nothing about it. It gives them an excuse. Knowing this, I am hesitant to ever say... *“yeah, that’s normal.”* Maybe I shouldn’t make assumptions, but I assume people come to me because they want my help. I am not going to be able to help them if I downplay the seriousness of their situation. Subluxations are serious and need to be dealt with in a serious manner.

When people are subluxated, they have less life. The intelligence within can no longer properly regulate body function via the nerve system. The longer this goes on, the more health problems they will have. So, even though most people are subluxated that does not make it okay. Don’t give yourself any excuses. Do what’s right.
